

Timely Warning: Robbery On Campus

At about 11:30 PM on the evening of July 3, 2017, UCPD officers were dispatched to the area of Olmstead Hall and Parking Lot 6 regarding a robbery that had just occurred. In speaking with the victim, the officers learned that about 20 minutes earlier two men had forcefully taken the victim's property. The victim told officers that while standing near the south west access to the Olmstead loading dock, they were rapidly approached by two men. Despite the victim's efforts to the contrary, the suspects were able to quickly grab the victim's property and run off.

The victim described the suspects as follows:

1. Black male, about 20 years old. He was reported being about six feet tall, with a thin build and last seen wearing a white shirt and jeans.
2. Hispanic male, about 20 years old. He was reported being about 5'8" tall, with a medium build and was last seen wearing a white shirt and jeans.

There was no vehicle seen or described by the victim.

Responding officers checked the area for anyone matching the description provided by the victim but were unable to locate the suspects. UCPD officers documented the incident and detectives will be following up on leads in the investigation. Further information will be released to the campus community as it becomes appropriate to do so.
