

Crime Alert: Robbery on Campus

At about 10:35 PM on July 21, 2017, UCPD officers were dispatched to the area of 100 Aberdeen Drive regarding a robbery that had occurred. About 15 minutes earlier, the victim was riding his bike in front of the A&I Residence Hall. A subject, described as a black male adult, 5'9" 35 years old, wearing dark clothing and black towel around his head, exited a black SUV. He walked in front of victim and forcefully grabbed his bicycle and demanded his wallet. The victim, fearing for his safety, got off the bike, pushed it towards the suspect and ran to the front lobby of A&I residence hall where he called the police. The suspect rode off on his bicycle towards Linden Street. The victim was not injured.

Responding officers checked the area for anyone matching the description, but were unable to locate the suspect or the SUV. UCPD will be investigating this crime.

Though the Escort Service does not operate during the summer sessions, UCPD Community Service Officers are available for escorts on campus anytime.
