

UCPD Crime Alert: Theft on Campus

On December 7, 2017 at about 11:30 p.m., UCPD officers were dispatched to the area of the A&I Residence Hall regarding a theft of property that had just occurred. The victim reported to dispatch that two men had flagged him down on Aberdeen Drive and, after he stopped adjacent to them, one reached through the open window of his car and forcefully removed his property from the interior. The victim last saw the suspects running in two directions; the first went into the A&I Residence Hall and disappeared from view, the second suspect ran towards Linden Street and then east on Linden.

Upon their arrival officers checked the area surrounding the residence hall as well as the hall itself, but were unable to find anyone matching the suspect's description.

The victim described the suspects as follows:

1. Black male adult, 20 to 25 years old, about 6 feet tall with a medium-to-light build. He had dark eyes and wore a full beard. He was wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt, dark pants and white and gold "Jordan" shoes.
2. Black male adult, 20-25 years old, about 6 feet tall and also with a medium-to-light build. This suspect too had dark eyes and wore a short, scruffy beard. He was last seen wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and dark pants.
