

UCPD Crime Alert: Attempted Carjacking's Occurred on Campus

On Friday, January 12, 2018, at about 1:30 pm, UCPD officers were dispatched to an attempted carjacking in the area of North parking Lot of the Bannockburn Village Apartments (3637 Canyon Crest Drive). The suspect tried to take a female driver's car by force. The suspect was not able to get control of the vehicle and he fled the scene on foot. UCPD coordinated a search for the suspect.

At 2:43 pm, the same suspect attempted take a second female driver's car by force at the University Plaza Apartments (1020 Linden Street). The suspect was not able to get control of that vehicle and again fled on foot.

No weapons were seen and neither victim was injured.

Both victims described the lone suspect as follows:

Hispanic male adult, about 25 years old, 5'6" tall and about 150 pounds. He had a shaved head and brown eyes, he was last seen wearing a grey striped shirt, jeans and sneakers. He also had tattoos on his hands.

While searching for the suspect UCPD dispatch sent a text alert to the community regarding the circumstances of the calls. Though officers searched both Bannockburn and University Plaza, as well as surrounding properties, they were unable to find the suspect. The City of Riverside Police Department has been notified to be on the lookout for the suspect. UCPD detectives will be investigating these crimes; we will notify the community via email if have more information.
