

UCPD Crime Alert: Sexual Assault Occurred on Campus

On 5/26/16, at about 1:20 a.m., a woman was walking on the path way from the Pentland Hills to the Lothian residence halls. A male subject yelled out a “cat call” and approached her from behind. The suspect hugged her with one arm and grabbed her chest area with the other hand. The woman was able to run away and call UCPD. The woman said that she thought the suspect was intoxicated. She was not injured.

The suspect was described as follows:

- Male Indian, early 20’s, black hair, 5’-7” to 5’-8”, 140-160 lbs., wearing a unknown color flannel shirt and dark jeans

UCPD officers responded and checked the area, but could not find the suspect. UCPD will be investigating this crime. We will be providing extra police patrols of this path way area nightly.
