

UCPD Crime Alert: Suspicious Incident in Campus Housing

On 6/11/16, at 3:57 a.m., UCPD was dispatched to a suspicious incident at the on-campus Glen Mor housing complex. We received a second-hand report of the following:

A group of friends were gathered in an apartment at Glen Mor. A woman in the group went outside to dump some trash. She returned and reported to her friend that somewhere in the area of the third floor of the M building, a man of unknown race, contacted her in the hallway. He asked if she wanted to come into his apartment while simultaneously pulling her arm towards him. The woman said “no”, ran away and left the area. One of her friends reported the incident to UCPD.

UCPD is conducting an investigation into this incident. The intent of the male subject is not known. We are seeking the community’s help in gathering more information about this incident.
