

UCPD Crime Alert: Women's Restroom Incidents on Campus

UCPD is seeking the campus community's help with a recent series of surreptitious recordings reported in women's restrooms on campus. UCPD is investigating the following incidents where a male subject has attempted to secretly video record females in restroom stalls using a cell phone:

6/03/2016	3:35 p.m.	Olmsted Theater women's restroom near room 420
6/28/2016	3:00 p.m.	Olmsted Theater women's restroom near room 420
7/22/2016	11:20 a.m.	Humanities and Social Sciences restroom (1403B)

The description in all three incidents is limited to a male subject holding a cell phone under the stall. In one incident, his hand was described as large and light skinned. He was wearing black "Lacoste" leather textured slip on shoes and dark blue jeans. The cellphone might have been a white Samsung or Microsoft phone with sharp edges and no case.

If you have seen any suspicious activity in or around women's restrooms on campus, please call 951-827-5222 to report it to UCPD. We will let the community know if we make progress in the investigation of these crimes.
