

## **UCPD Crime Alert: Indecent Exposure on Campus**

On October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2016, at about 4:45 pm, a UCR student was walking through Lot 26 near the Canyon Crest entrance. As she walked down the aisle towards Rustin Avenue, she approached a black Ford Taurus stopped in the middle of the aisle. As she got closer to the Ford Taurus, she saw a man inside, talking on his cell phone; she also noticed that his penis was exposed and he appeared to be masturbating. As she passed the car, the vehicle left the parking lot from the Canyon Crest entrance. The driver did not exit the vehicle or attempt physical contact with the victim during the exchange.

The suspect's vehicle was caught on video by security cameras in the area. UCPD detectives are actively investigating this case and have created a flyer with the suspect's vehicle and his description; this flyer can be found on the UCPD [website](#), under the heading On Campus Crime Alerts - Handled by UCPD.
