

UCPD Crime Alert: Sexual Assault Occurred in the Residence Halls

UCPD is investigating a report of a sexual assault which occurred in a campus residence hall a few days ago. The survivor said that in the early morning hours of January 15, 2017, she was in the common hallway lounge of a residence hall when a male unlawfully touched and kissed her. The victim was able to leave before the suspect could commit any further crime against her.

UCPD detectives are investigating this as a sexual assault. As of this notification, the suspect was described as a white male of unknown age, wearing an unknown color hoodie sweatshirt. As the investigation is on-going, additional information will be released in the near future.
