

UCPD Crime Alert: Unknown Man Found Inside Apartment

On May 13, 2017, at about 6:00 am, UCPD officers were dispatched to the area of the Stonehaven Apartments regarding a report of a man inside the apartment of a UCR student. The caller told police that she had awoken at about that time to discover a man she did not know standing in her room. Shortly after waking, the man left the residence. After receiving the call, officers responded to the apartments but were unable to locate anyone matching the description offered by the caller.
