

### UCPD Crime Alert: Attempted Robbery on Campus

At 1:13 PM on July 25, 2017, UCPD officers were dispatched to the area of Big Springs Road and East Campus Drive regarding a robbery that had just occurred. The victim reported that about 10 minutes earlier a dark grey Nissan sedan drove next to the victim who was walking on East Campus Drive towards Big Springs Road. The passenger of the vehicle, described as a black male adult 6' tall, 200 lbs, wearing a black t-shirt and shorts, got out and offered her a flier for a party. As the suspect handed her the flier, he grabbed at her wallet. Two bystanders saw the incident and ran to help the victim. The suspect got into the vehicle and drove away eastbound on Big Spring Road. No property was taken and the victim was not injured.

Responding officers checked the area, but were unable to locate the suspect or vehicle. UCPD will be investigating this crime. Further information will be released to the campus community as it becomes appropriate to do so.
