

## **UCPD Crime Alert: Robbery Occurred Off-Campus**

On 01/02/18 at 6:27 pm, a robbery occurred at the Sprint store located at 1299 University Avenue at the University Village. The suspect, who was described as a light-skinned black male adult, approximately 20 years old, with a tall and thin build, entered the store and brandished a silver colored handgun and stole \$500 from an employee.

The suspect was last seen leaving the store on foot on University Avenue towards the Cocos Restaurant. UCRD and Riverside PD officers responded and checked the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.

The Riverside Police Department will be investigating this crime.
