

## **UCPD Crime Alert – Series of Sexual Batteries Occurred On & Near Campus**

On 05/15/2018, four sexual batteries occurred on and near campus involving a male suspect riding a bicycle. The first incident occurred at about 10:30 a.m., where a woman near lot 30 who reported being slapped on the buttocks by a suspect riding a bicycle behind her. About 15 minutes later, a second woman in the same area said she was touched in the genital area by a suspect who passed her on a bicycle. A third incident occurred at 5:45 p.m. near University Avenue and West Campus when a suspect rode by on a bicycle and squeezed her buttocks. In these three incidents, the suspect was described as:

- Male, possibly Hispanic, in his early twenties, medium build, dark complexion, with a short cut beard, shoulder length curly hair, and riding a bicycle. He was last seen wearing a baseball hat (light multi-color baseball hat with a pattern) with his hair protruding from the front bill of the cap, a white shirt and unknown colored shorts.

Later at 6:00 p.m., a fourth incident was reported in the crosswalk of University Avenue and West Campus Drive (off-campus) where a suspect rode by a woman and grabbed her thigh. The suspect in this incident was described as:

- A white male, thin build, with grey wavy hair and riding a white bicycle. He was last seen wearing a white and red hat, grey long sleeve shirt and denim shorts.
