

UCPD Crime Alert: Lewd Act Occurred Near Campus

On 12/07/18, at 3:00 a.m., a female UCR student reported seeing a man exposing himself and masturbating outside her window at the University Towers Apartments at 3500 Iowa Ave.

The suspect was described as a Black male in his 30's, wearing jeans and a black shirt.

The Riverside Police Department is investigating this crime.

We encourage our UCR students living in apartments to be diligent about keeping their doors and windows locked. Be aware of your surroundings and immediately report suspicious activity in and around apartment complexes.
