

# **UCPD Crime Alert: Sexual Assault**

On May 25, 2017 UCPD officers were dispatched to a report of a sexual assault that had just occurred. Officers met with the survivor, who related the details of the incident as follows:

The survivor met the suspect via a social media app and arranged, via that app, to meet in person at an on-campus location. The suspect and survivor drove to another on-campus location where, after a short time, the suspect sexually assaulted the survivor.

UCPD detectives are investigating this incident. We will update this timely warning with any new, pertinent details when it is appropriate to do so.

Given their prevalence, UCPD suggests the following strategies when using any social application:

- Meet new people in a public place.
- When possible, meet in a group setting.
- Let a trusted friend know where you are going and when you expect to return.
- Do not provide personal details to unknown people.
