**Alphabetical Title: Constitutional Requirements**

**PURPOSE**

To provide a temporary addition to Lexipol Policy 100.3 until the 2013 mid-year update is published. In this modification, subsection 100.3.1 is added to the policy in accordance with the recommendations in the Robinson/Edley report on Response to Protests on UC campuses.

**POLICY**

**100.3 CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

All employees shall observe and comply with every person's clearly established rights under the United States and California Constitutions.

**100.3.1 FREE SPEECH AND ASSEMBLY**

The public has the right to assemble in a manner consistent with university policies as well as state and federal law, understanding that, while civil disobedience has had an historic role in our democracy and in the University of California it is not protected speech and there may be consequences for those who engage in it.
