

UCPD Crime Alert: Robbery Occurred Near Campus

On May 21, 2019, at 9:00 p.m., a lone woman was approached by a male suspect in the parking lot after using the ATM at the Chase Bank located at the University Village shopping center. The suspect brandished a firearm and demanded her wallet. The suspect took her wallet and ran south on Iowa Ave. towards University Ave. The woman called the Riverside Police Department to report the incident.

The suspect was described as a thin statured dark skinned male, 20 years old, 6 feet tall, wearing a light grey hoodie. The area was searched by responding RPD officers, but the suspect was not found.

The Riverside Police Department is investigating this crime. Please use extra caution when using an ATM during the hours of darkness.
