UCPD Crime Alert: Robbery Occurred Near Campus

On 06/06/18, at 8:25 p.m., a woman was getting in her parked car at 1201 University Avenue (University Village) when she was approached by an unknown woman. The woman simulated that she had a weapon underneath her shirt and demanded miscellaneous items from inside the victim's car. The suspect took items from the car and fled on foot. The victim was not injured.

The suspect was described as:

• White female adult, about 30 years old, with blonde curly hair, wearing a baseball style hat, pink shirt and blue denim jeans
