

## **UCPD Crime Alert: Robbery Occurred Near Campus**

On March 18, 2020, at 8:00 p.m., a woman in front of a business at 1242 University Ave., adjacent to the UC Riverside Extension Center, was approached by a man. That man forcefully took her cell phone and ran to a grey colored Nissan sedan that was driven by another subject. The sedan drove east on University Ave. towards the 215 Freeway. Riverside Police Department and UCPD officers checked the area for the vehicle, but they were unable to find it. The woman was not injured.

The suspect was described as a dark skinned male, tall in height, last seen wearing a grey hoodie and red pants.

The Riverside Police Department is investigating this crime. Please use extra caution when frequenting businesses in this area during the hours of darkness.
