Burglary

On 8-22-2022 at about 10:28 p.m., UCR Police and Campus Safety (UCR PD) received a call from a student resident at Bannockburn who discovered an unknown male subject inside his apartment, holding his property. The suspect left the apartment upon being discovered.

UCR police quickly arrived and located the suspect behind Bannockburn. The suspect (not affiliated with UCR) was arrested for residential burglary. The suspect was in possession of property that may belong to other victims.
