

Crime Alert

UCRPD received a report on June 16, 2023 that a male subject had entered a residence, possibly through a sliding glass door, at the Falkirk Apartments. The sole resident of the apartment heard noises coming from the living room, exited her bedroom and noticed the male subject. The resident asked the subject to leave the apartment upon which he did without incident. The resident described the suspect as:

A dark skinned male, about 20-25 years old with an average build, and about 5'07" tall
