## **Crime Alert**

UCRPD received a report on August 2nd, 2023, at approximately 1508 hours, of a past burglary of a residence at the UCR International Village Apartments located at 1100 Everton Place. Information was provided to officers that the crime occurred between 08/01/2023 and 08/02/2023. The resident had told the officers they had left their rear window open during this time frame and it appears that was the point of entry into the apartment. The resident noticed items missing from inside the residence which included electronic devices. There was no suspect information available at the time of the report.
