Clery Notification – Indecent Exposure

On **July 6, 2026, at approximately 9:32 p.m.**, the UC Riverside Police Department responded to and investigated an indecent exposure involving a suspect who is currently on active parole and is a registered sex offender pursuant to California Penal Code § 290.

The investigation resulted in the suspect's arrest. The suspect has been apprehended and booked into the county jail.

Suspect Description:

Male adult, approximately in his early 20s, thin build, about 5 feet 7 inches tall, clean-shaven, with dark hair worn in a “man bun,” wearing a black sweatshirt with white lettering, long black shorts, white socks, and black sandals.

Although the suspect is in custody and there is no known ongoing threat to the campus community related to this incident, investigators are working to determine whether there may be additional victims or witnesses who have not yet come forward.
